This SDRCHA Breeding Contract is transferable to the Mare Owner who purchases the stallion service. The amount the breeding fee will be sold for is 50% of the advertised service fee. Any live foal guarantee made shall be in accordance with the Stallion Owner's Breeding Contract and is only offered to the initial Purchaser of the contract. Any vet bills, mare care charges, chute fee and semen shipping fees shall be the responsibility of the Mare Owner. Further, the Stallion Owner by participating in this SDRCHA program, does understand, agree and accept that the SDRCHA members, officers and representatives are not liable for death, sickness and/or accidental injury including consequential damages, to the stallion and/or the Stallion Owner during participation in this breeding program caused by either negligent or intentional act of any party to the contract. The SDRCHA strongly suggests that upon receipt of the mare for breeding, that the Stallion Owner or representative has the Mare Owner sign their individual breeding contract in addition to the SDRCHA transfer breeding contract.
